
North / South axe : Highway A20 (Paris – Toulouse)



OUTLINE PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

According to the ICF Wildwater Canoeing rules 2019 (art 3.5 to 3.9):

Each athlete must wear shoes, a helmet with a strap fastened under the chin and a buoyancy jacket. They must be in good working condition.

A buoyancy jacket must comply with the current industry standard that is, EN ISO 12402-5 (Level 50) or any national standard that meets the same requirements (art 3.7).

The safety helmet must comply with EN 1385 or any national standard that meets the same requirements (art 3.8).

All boats must be fitted with fully inflated air bags (art 3.5).

All paddlers must wear shoes on their feet. Shoes must have a thicker sole to protect feet. Shoes must fit in a way that they will not come off in a capsize or be release from boat (article 3.9, ICF Wildwater Canoeing rules).

All boats must be filled with air bags in both the front and the back of boat (article 3.5, ICF Wildwater Canoeing rules).

- Team personnel must also be submitted for accreditation at this time. These entries will be used to produce the accreditation cards for all teams.

VISA REQUIREMENT

France is a state-member of the European Union. The French Embassy in your country will provide you with all detailed information about visas. You will find details in the website on French Foreign Affairs Ministry (http://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/).

Please inform in advance but no later than **17th September 2021** the Organising Committee together with the visa form whether your team needs entry visas to France.

COVID-19 HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOL

Each Participating National Federation will be expected to have undertaken their own risk assessment and have a Covid-19 safety protocol in place and will require to have taken the precautionary measures prior to travel.

Each Participating National Federation is responsible for all costs (including medication) should any member of their Team be required to go into quarantine at any time from arrival to departure and/or be hospitalised or to return to the country of departure. The ICF, the Host National Federation and the Host Organising Committee will try to support the concerned person as much as they can.

The ICF, the National Federation oblige all nations to provide EU DIGITAL COVID CERTIFICATE (Health Pass) AND a negative PCR test (less than 72 hours) before participating in the competition.

During the competition, it will be possible to realised antigenic tests as well as PCR tests on site at Parking des Rivières.
