## INTRODUCTION

From August 14th to 16th 2015, the stadium of Pau-Pyrénées will welcome the final stage of the 2015 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup. One year before the 2016 Rio Olympic Games. Two years before the 2017 ICF Canoe World Championships in Pau. The international competition is one of the last rounds to be organized before Olympics in Rio (Brazil) and 2015 ICF Canoe Slalom World Championships in Lee Valley (Great Britain). It should gather a large number of delegations from all around the world.

It will be an opportunity for the general public to discover our spectacular discipline and the various athletes preset for World Championships.

The city of Pau and its metropolitan area has a big sporting culture and has already proved their capacity to host events at the highest level : Tour de France (cycling), CCI 5\* (riding), pelota world championships (2010), ... and for canoe slalom two ICF World Cup stages in 2009 and 2012.

One of the objectives of this 2015 ICF Canoe Slalom World Cup final stage is to prepare all publics to experience some great moments in Pau with a three-year events programme :

- 2015 : ICF Canoe Slalom Final World Cup – 14th to 16th August
- 2016 : ICF Canoe Slalom World & Wildwater Canoeing Sprint World Cups - 17th to 19th June
- 2017 : ICF Canoe World Championships (Canoe Slalom & Wildwater Canoeing Sprint) - 12th to 17th September

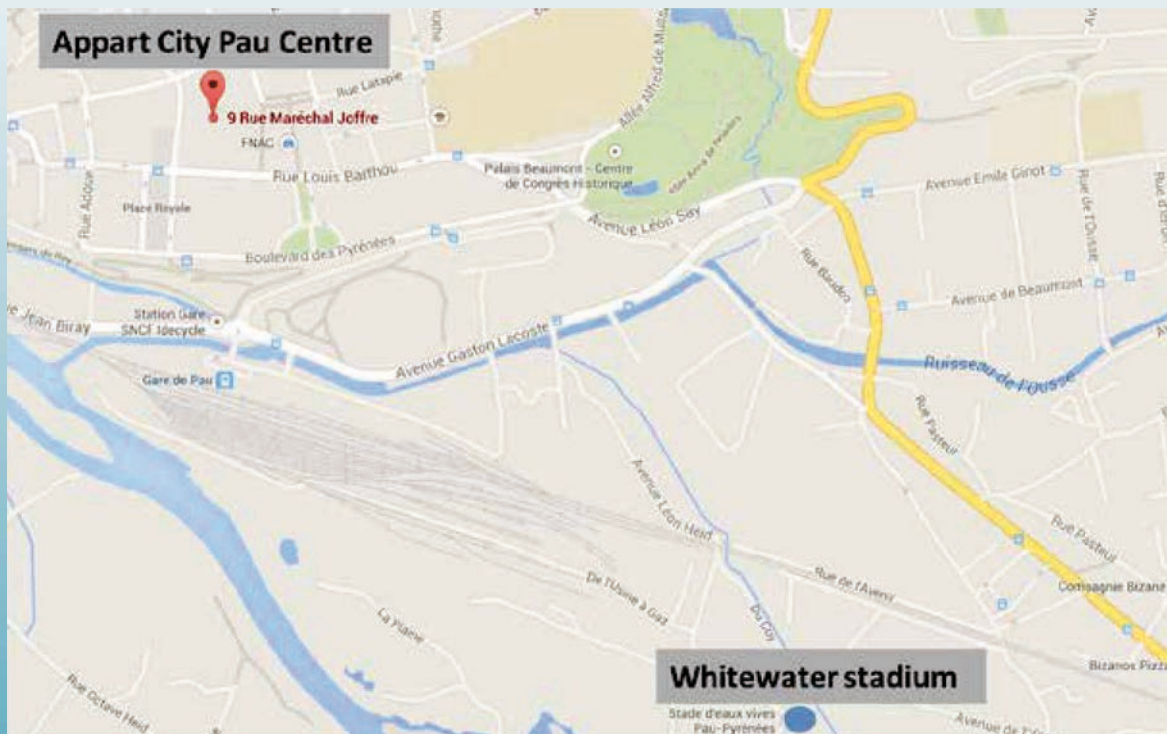

### *Do you need visas ?*

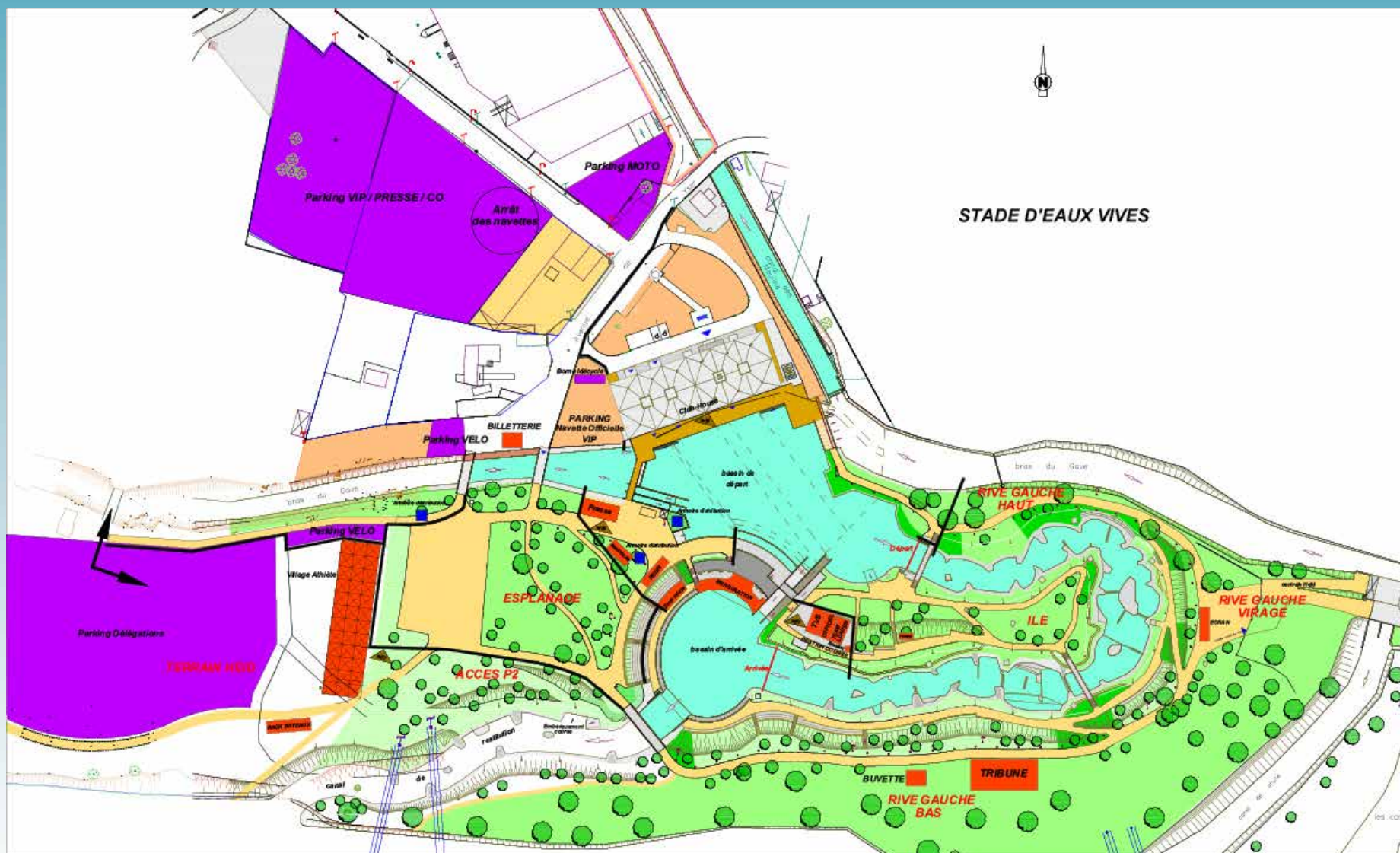
