START AND FINISH PLACE: Canottieri Padova Asd

AWARDS: They will be made at the end of all scheduled races. The category will be established and the awarding with medal will be carried out, with a minimum of three registered athletes.

CASH PRIZE: At the end of all the scheduled races, the timed classification in single boat will be drawn up, unique for all categories and boats. The three best times will be rewarded with a cash prize worth:

1st place €400 2nd place €200 3rd place €100







DOPING: During the event, anti-doping checks can be carried out both by NADO and by the Ministry of Health. Antidoping Investigative Inspectors (NAS personnel accredited by NADO - ITALY) may also be present, with the functions and prerogatives established by art. 23 of the Anti-Doping Sport Regulations (Circular 08/2016)

NOTE:

- > The race program and the starting modalities will be presented during the team leaders meeting;
- ➤ The weight control of the boats can be made after each arrival;
- > The use of a life jacket is mandatory for categories U16;
- Boats must be rendered unsinkable;
- The use of suitable footwear for portages is recommended (not barefoot).
- > The event will take place in the presence of any weather condition that does not affect the safety and health of the participants. If, due to force majeure or any other cause not attributable to the organization, the event does not take place, the participation fee will not be refunded.
