## GREETINGS FROM THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE

The Organising Committee of the International Canoe Sprint Regatta is honoured to welcome your team and your athletes to Auronzo di Cadore, located in the spectacular Bellunese Dolomites. The Lake of Santa Caterina was the stage for the 2018 ECA Junior and U23 Canoe Sprint European Championships and in July 2023 hosted the ICF Junior and U23 World Championships. Auronzo is pleased to host your teams and athletes for training camps and stages, with services that allow you to follow your athlete's training.





## TRAINING CAMPS

### in Auronzo di Cadore - ITALY

The Lake of Santa Caterina, located 840m a.s.l., is the ideal place to hold your training camps with your canoe/kayak sprint and dragonboat teams.

A number of hotels are located within walking distance to the lake. The organisation provides you with a place to store your canoes, pontoons for the descent and ascent of athletes and boats, a catamaran or a dinghy with motor (Zodiac, Honda) to follow training sessions, the use of automatic starting blocks.



This service is available **from 10 June to 10 July 2026**, excluding the days **2-3-4-5 July** reserved for the international competition. To arrange other periods (e.g. August or September 2026), contact must be made at least two months in advance.

If you are unable to bring your canoes/kayaks, you can contact the major European rental suppliers: Nelo, Plastex, Vajda, Elio, etc.

To have one or more BUK or Champion dragon boats available, make a request in the email indicated above.

For both canoe/kayak and dragon boat activities, paddles are not provided (with some exceptions).



### Would you like to make the most of your stay in Auronzo?

When your athletes are not training on the water, Auronzo offers many other outdoor activities. Immersed in nature, choose any of the numerous walking trails and visit the refuges, or take the 30km mountain bike track towards Misurina. Hike around the UNESCO world heritage site of the Tre Cime di Lavaredo, or visit the forest of Somadida, whose trees supplied the timber for the Venetian galleons. Next to the ski area, you will find an Adventure park as well as Europe's longest Fun Bob.

- Final race times will be communicated at the end of the club accreditations with the consignment of the race program.
- Boat weight control will be conducted, starting with the heats, for all teams qualifying for the following race phase.
- The minor finals will be held only if there are more than 18 athletes registered for the race.
- Athletes must be correctly registered with their Federation (as at Nominal Entry deadline) to be able to participate in the above races and Paracanoe athletes must be regularly classified.
- Whatever is not mentioned in the current document will then refer to the ICF Sprint Race Regulations and the ICF Paracanoe Technical Race Regulations.
- During the event, antidoping controls may be conducted.

## **REGISTRATION OPENS: 01 MARCH 2026**

### **Registration/participation Fees**

Considering that the race is also open to foreign clubs which may generate a higher-than-expected participation, the Organising Committee reserves the right to close registrations early. Before registering, foreign clubs should send the authorisation to participate provided by their National Federations. Indicated below are the registration methods.

**Registration/participation Fee:** The registration fee is Euro 40,00 per athlete for U16, Junior and Senior, Euro 60,00 per athlete for Masters, and Euro 15,00 per athlete for Paracanoe.

For the foreign teams, the participation fee will be doubled if you organise your own accommodation and do not pass through the Organising Committee.

**The registration fee includes: race registration, medical assistance during the races, insurance.**

**The registration fee permits each athlete to participate in ALL the races allowed by the regulations.**

**The Organising Committee reserves the right to close registrations early if the number of athletes registered does not permit the races to be held over the scheduled 3-day period.**

From 1 May 2026 the Organising Committee reserves the possibility of not providing assistance with accommodation reservations.

### **Payments and Deadlines:**

- 60% until 30 April 2026.
- 40% until 12 June 2026.

A credit card will be required to guarantee the reservation.

### **Cancellation Terms:**

- until 30 April 2026 - free cancellation and refund of amounts paid (less bank fees).
- from 1 May to 12 June 2026 - in case of cancellation penalty is 50% (plus bank fees) of amount paid.
- from 13 June 2026 - in case of cancellation there will be no refund of amounts paid.

The amounts for the Accommodation SHOULD NOT BE PAID TOGETHER with the event registration fees. IT IS POSSIBLE TO USE THE SAME BANK ACCOUNT indicated above, but the reason should be: Accommodation fees – Name of Team/Club.

**The reservation of the accommodation will be confirmed by the chronological arrival of the payments because the O.C. will have the right to close reservations if the numbers exceed the capacity of the area.**

## **SERVICES**

### **TRANSPORT**

Auronzo is located only 135 km from Venice and is easily accessible by all major forms of transport. For those who arrive:

- **By car:** Auronzo can be reached from Germany (A22 and Brennero pass), from Austria (A23 /Tarvisio), from Slovenia (A34 Gorizia or A4 Trieste), while from Italy take the A27 Venezia-Belluno highway.
- **By plane:** The closest airports are Treviso (126 km) [www.trevisoairport.it](http://www.trevisoairport.it) and Venice (137 km) [www.veniceairport.it](http://www.veniceairport.it).
- **By train:** The closest railway station is in **Calalzo-Pieve di Cadore-Cortina**, 15 km from Auronzo. The closest main railway station is **Venezia-Mestre**.

### **BUS TRANSFERS TO/FROM VENICE/TREVISO AIRPORTS and MESTRE RAILWAY STATION**

**We are able to assist you with your transfer to/from the airports of Venice and Treviso and to/from the Venezia-Mestre railway station. Please contact us at: [auronzocanoe@gmail.com](mailto:auronzocanoe@gmail.com)** (approximation of costs to/from Venezia-Mestre railway station or to/from Venice and Treviso airports are Euro 45,00 one way and Euro 85,00 return, per person).

**NB:** These costs may vary depending on the type of transport requested (bus, minivan, taxi etc).

**SERVICES** - Hygiene services are available in various parts of the regatta venue.

### **BOAT RENTAL**

Please contact the boat suppliers directly for your boat requirements (Plastex, Nelo, Vajda etc). Please let us know of the approximate number and types of boats hired for us to better organise the spaces.

### **INSURANCE**

While insurance is covered with your registration fee, all official participants of the International Regatta are strongly advised to take out a medical insurance policy in their respective countries.

### **MEDICAL CARE**

An ambulance and first aid will be available at the regatta venue for all participants in the International Regatta.

The costs above the regular first aid and ambulance services are to be covered by your medical insurance policy. The Organising Committee is not responsible to cover your expenses in connection with hospital treatment, dental treatment or any other medical treatment.
